

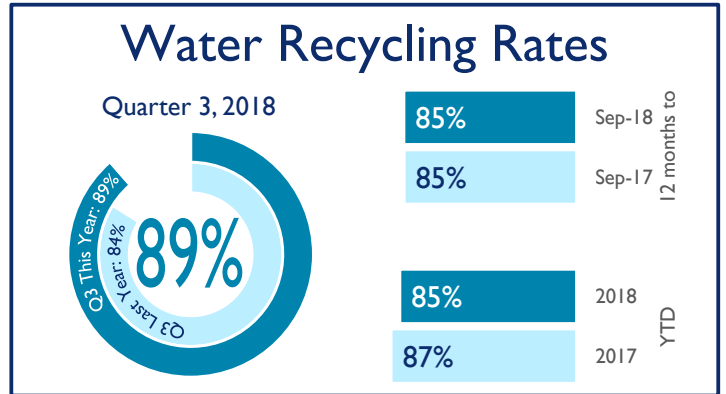
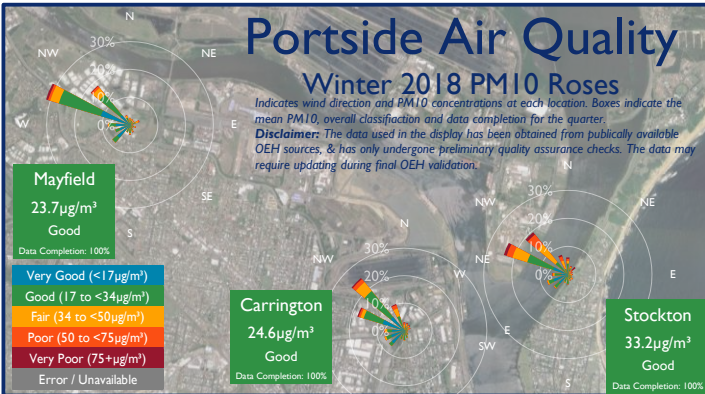

Carrington Yard Machine Lighting Improvements

Reclaimers: 90.1% Reduction	
Stackers: 93.1% Reduction	
All Yard Machines: 91.8% Reduction	

CCT Yard Machines have been upgraded to LED lighting, with the top half of the machine operating with a timer function that can be activated on the machine or remotely.
